Synopsis: For whole group instruction, I will explain the different types of poetry. We will look at several different types and talk about rhyme schemes. I will then put students into groups of three. Each group will have one day to write a poem over anything they choose as long as it is one of the specific types we have discussed and age appropriate. Once they have a rough draft of their poems, they will turn it in to me for approval. After I approve, each group will use Specdrum to put a beat or music to their poem. Once they have put the beat or music to it, they will use the Clips app to record it. When each group has their videos completed, they will present it to the class.
