Classroom Rules

We will have...

- 1. Listening Ears. We will listen to the teacher and follow directions quickly.
- 2. Focused Minds. We will stay on task and do our best.
- 3. Raised Hands. We will raise our hands when we want to speak or get up from our seats.
- 4. Quiet Mouths. We will use our soft voices when we speak.
- 5. Walking Feet. We will walk, not run, when we move about the classroom.
- 6. Controlled Bodies. We will keep our hands and feet to ourselves.
- 7. Open Hearts. We will speak and act kindly toward one another.

Technology Rules

We will...

- 1. listen, follow directions, and only use the iPad as instructed.
- 2. clear our desks and wash our hands before using the iPads.

<u>Consequences</u>

Consequences for not following these rules are subject to teacher discretion based on each individual situation. More information regarding the specific rules, their consequences, and Class Dojo are available on our classroom website.

If students do not exhibit appropriate behavior after 3 verbal reminders of the same Classroom Rule, a Dojo Point will be taken away. If 3 Dojo Points are taken away for the same offense in the same day, the student will be sent to the principal's office. For severe behavior that disrupts the entire classroom environment, the student will be escorted to the principal's office. Bullying will NOT be tolerated.

If students do not exhibit appropriate behavior after 2 verbal reminders of the same Technology or Internet Rule, a Dojo Point will be taken away. If students repeat the offense after the lost Dojo Point, they will lose their technology and internet privileges for the remainder of the day. If their behavior continues after that, privileges may be lost for extended periods of time. Technology brought from home will be held in the office until dismissal time. Cyberbullying will NOT be tolerated.

Plagiarism, Copyright, & Fair Use

Plagiarism involves using someone else's original work without giving them credit. A student is plagiarizing if they copy another student's assignment or have someone else complete an assignment for them, such as a peer, parent/guardian, or sibling. Plagiarism and cheating will not be tolerated, as they only hinder true academic progress.

The 2nd grade teachers will work together to find instructional materials that adhere to copyright laws and fair use policies in order to avoid plagiarism of already published materials. As the need arises, discuss with your student the importance of original work. Please see our classroom website for more information about copyright and fair use. Resources will be provided on the website to assist you and your child in understanding what they can and can't use in the completion of schoolwork.

Each signature demonstrates understanding of this contract and agreement to the rules, consequences, and policies included. The teacher reserves the right to modify the contract as necessary and will review the changes with students and parents/guardians as they occur.
