Type	<p>Drill and Practice-The students would be practicing math skills that the teacher has them practice, and the app adjusts to their specific learning level. Whatever skill that they are trying to learn, the app will continue to give them questions until they finish that challenge, and then they can move up to a harder level, in the same skill.</p> <p>Discovery Learning: If the teacher wanted to use this as a way to teach a new concept, then it would be a trial and error type of discovery learning because when the student gives a wrong answer it corrects them and gives them a reason why their answer was wrong, then gives them another chance to answer the question.</p>
Curriculum	Practicing or learning math skills.
Environment(s):	This app can be used in the classroom, or at home. Many reviews say that they used this app during the summer for their children to keep up their math skills and not digress backwards. We feel like this would be a great tool for teachers to use in their classroom after the math topic has been taught to practice, or it could

Cost	The first section that you play is free, then you have to subscribe, and after you subscribe, you will receive the first week free. The cost can either be billed quarterly or annually. If it is billed quarterly, it costs \$29.99. If it is billed annually, it costs \$59.99.
Describe the app	This app is a math game centered software that can be used for both a review session or to teach new concepts. The app has math games for practice and it doesn't make the student seem like they are learning, which is sometimes the best and students learn more that way. As the student completes levels and earns stars, they are able to buy fish for their aquarium, or animals for their jungle, which makes the child want to work towards learning and practicing to get more stars.
