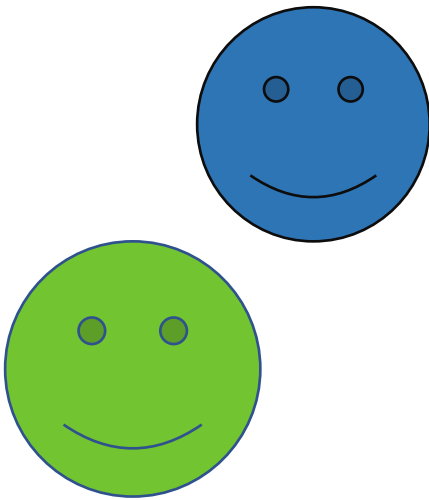

**Copyright:** Dictionary.com defines copyright as the “legal right granted to an author, a composer, a playwright, a publisher, or a distributor to exclusive publication, production, sale,

**Fair Use:** Fair use goes under the Copyright Act. Fair use allows individuals to use certain copyrighted work without permission in limited ways, such as making photocopies.
