<u>Clips</u>

Storyboard:

- 1. Choose paper, any paper. Explain that it can be ANY paper.
- 2. Fold paper in half, hamburger style. Show the hamburger style. It does not have to be a perfect fold. Show how mine isn't.
- 3. Explain that the drawing utensil can be anything, but erasable things are better. Draw half shaped tear drop, show it to camera. Fix it, show that.
- 4. Cut out shape, with paper still folded. It does not have to be perfect.
- 5. Show shape once cut out. Show left over paper and the idea of reusing it.
- 6. Write "to" and "from/love" on the shape (Valentine).

Clips is being used to show students how to make a Valentine at a Valentines Day party. The valentines are simple but allow for students to decorate in however way they would like, since they are paper hearts.

- 1. Sunny Weather
- 2. Cloudy Weather
- 3. Rainy Weather
- 4. Stormy Weather
- 5. Snowy Weather
- 6. Tornado Weather

***Pictures go with each weather type, along with music/sounds that match the "mood" of each weather.

Four other ways to use iMovie:

- 1. End of the year graduation video.
- 2. Welcome to (insert grade) video.
- 3. Informational, with lesson info.
- 4. Students can create movies as a project.
