Classroom Rules

- 1. Follow Directions the first time.
- 2. Raise your hand before speaking.
- 3. Listen when others are speaking.
- 4. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
- 5. Be respectful.

Technology/Computer/Tablet Rules

- 1. Students will only use the classroom technology when instructed by Miss Koons.
- 2. Students will be gentle and always take care of our classroom technology.
- 3. Students will only use our classroom technology for educational purposes approved by Miss Koons.
- 4. Students will keep all food and drinks off computer desks and off their desks when using the tablets.
- 5. Students should report any issues or problems with our classroom technology to Miss Koons immediately.

6. Unless they are told otherwise, students will only be permitted 30 minutes of technology use a day in our classroom.

Internet Rules

- 1. The use of the internet in our classroom is for safe sites and educational purposes only.
- 2. Students will always use netiquette (good behavior on the internet).
- 3. Students will only use nice and positive words when using the internet (no cyberbullying)
- 4. Students will not talk to anyone they do not know while using the internet.
- 5. Students will not stray from Miss Koons' approved websites when utilizing the internet.

Additional Information

Plagiarism is taking and/or using someone else's work and not giving them credit or citing them. Plagiarism will not be tolerated in our classroom. Copyright is the legal right to someone's own work. We may only use their work if their written permission is granted and we cite them. Fair use is a law that allows us to quote someone else's work without requiring a copyright form. It can only be used for specific purposes.

Consequences for Breaking the Rules



We use behavior clips in our classes. We all start on green each day. If your child stays on green, he/she had a good day. If he/she is on yellow, they had to clip down for breaking a rule. Orange means they received a 2nd warning for their behavior. Red means he/she received their 3rd and final warning resulting in a visit to the principal's office and will receive a note home explaining what happened. A parent signature will be requested.
