Oobleck can be used in a variety of ways, especially in a classroom. In this clip, and for the purpose of this assignment, it would be used for a science experiment. The Arkansas Frameworks Standard that would be used is: 2-PS1-1 Plan and conduct an investigation to describe and classify different kinds of materials by their observable properties.
