1. Grade level/Audience: 3rd Grade

2. <u>Curriculum topic:</u> History

3. Tools: Beebot and YouTube Video

4. Environment: Whole group

5. <u>Synopsis</u>: This lesson will start with a Christopher Columbus song on the projector. The kids with be encouraged to get up to dance, sing and clap. Once the students listen to the song, the teacher will get out a map mat that has Christopher Columbus' journey on it.
