To do this I will need:

- Paint
- Brush
- Cup of Water
- Plate of some kind
- Paper towels

1. Red + Blue = Purple

2. Yellow + Red = Orange

3. Blue + Yellow = Green

4. Red + Green = Brown

5. White + Red = Pink

I will have a poster of these color mixtures up on the walls so that the students can use them as reference during our projects.
