# **Internet Safety**

- It is extremely important to be aware of internet safety and the rules that will help you stay safe online.
  - NEVER give away personal information on the internet. (ex. name, address, phone number, picture.)
  - DO NOT talk to strangers on the internet.
  - If a stranger tries to communicate with you, immediately let myself, another teacher, or your parent know to get involved.
  - DO NOT try to purchase anything online without your parents' permission \*my class will not require any online purchases\*
  - o DO NOT bully your peers or other students online. (cyberbullying)
  - o DO NOT use your classmate's computers without their permission.

## **Rules for Technology**

- Here are our basic rules for using technology:
  - Always return the tablets and computers back to their "safe spot".
  - Always clean your keyboard with a disinfectant wipe at the EOD.
  - Limit of 1-hour computer time to do quizzes, work on homework, or go to any
    educational websites that are offered. \*subject to change depending on class
    activities\*
  - In groups: follow the position policy to determine who gets to work on the computer.
    - Position policy-group of three or four students that will work together on assignments. Group roles are assigned by numbers allowing each child to participate in a different way.

Here are a few important topics that we will cover more in class...

- Plagiarism:
  - Taking someone else's ideas and passing them as your own.
- Copyright:
  - The right that an author has to determine if their work can be used by others.
- Fair Use:
  - Gives permission to bypass copyright if the work is quoted verbatim and credit is given to the author. Acceptable for teaching, research, and reporting.

## **Consequences for Breaking Rules**

- I will give two warnings, if the rule is broken after that, punishment will follow.
  - Misuse of technology: the student will be banned from using technology in the classroom for one day, they will have to work on other school work and make-up missed work at home.
