

Acceptable Use Policy

Purpose.

The purpose of Ms. Pounds Acceptable Use policy is to ensure the teacher, student, and parent/guardian are in agreement with the terms of use expected within Ms.Pounds's students. As an active student and user of the materials and devices provided by the teacher and school, reading and signing off on the terms below confirms the students and guardian understand and accepts the policy and expectations completely. Any disagreements or failure to abide by the rules and regulations of this policy will result in immediate consequences.

Daily Classroom Rules

- 1. I will not make any classmate feel bad or uncomfortable with any form of bullying or harassment; THIS IS a BULLY-FREE ZONE!
- 2. Any drinks besides water will not be allowed in the classroom, and water will be removed from my area if we are using the laptops.
- 3. I will not interrupt class with conflict with other students; if there is an issue I will report it to Ms. Pounds before or after class.
- 4. If I don't have the necessary supplies I will get them out of the Student Supply Closet before class starts.
- 5. Any use of inappropriate language will result in an immediate disciplinary trip to the office and a mandatory Parent teacher conference.
- 6. let Ms. Pounds know and get an alternate assignment.

Computer/At Home Laptop Usage Rules

- 1. I will sufficiently use the internet for school related reason ONLY, at home practice is encouraged.
- 2. I will in no way abuse the privilege of having my device by using it to watch anything encouraging harsh or violent actions.
- 3. I will not lend my laptop to anyone, it is my responsibility to keep it in my possession for school related usage only. If I leave school with it, then it is my responsibility to return it.
- 4. While using the laptop at school I will make sure it is returned to the charging booth and sign off the checkout list to ensure I have returned it when it is due.
- 5. I will report any accidents or damages done to the laptop immediately after I am aware of them; Ms. Pounds will handle it accordingly.



Consequences

All issues following breaking any of the rules and agreements above will result in immediate action. There will be one warning given to every student if they fail to follow the agreements above. After the first warning. There will be a MANDATORY SCHEDULED conference call between the teacher and guardian of the student. If misbehavior continues the student's access to the devices provided will be limited and/or revoked and alternative assignments and assisted technology will be issued.

Your rights.

You as a student as well as the guardian are not required to agree and sign this policy, however you will not be issued your own laptop, instead you will have complete access to the classroom accessible devices to still affectively complete assignments, along with other alternative adjustments. It is completely understandable to disagree and not accept the terms of the policy, you will be held accountable only for what you agree with. As a guardian you will be held responsible for all actions taken out by your child, accountability will be handled accordingly.
