Description of Software: Users create their account (just by typing their name

and adding a profile image). Then the user chooses which timeline they would like

to create: date, time or event, and they name it. Then, they can add multiple things

to the timeline using a title, short description, full description, and image. Users

can save and share their work.

Impressions of Software: This app is very basic, but it gets to the point. You

can't make an elaborate timeline, but it is still a timeline that is useful. It didn't
