**Curriculum:** This app would fit into any lesson plan. It starts as a blank document and allows the user to create whatever they want. The app can be used for any subject or topic.

**Cost:** The app is free to download and has an in-app purchase of \$1.99 for Mind Map Unlock.

**Description of Software:** The app opens with a mind map made that gives instructions to the user on how the app works. To make a mind map, the user can add a text box and move the boxes around. The user can link the text bubbles to create a web. The text bubbles can be customized by changing the color, shape or font size. That's all the app can do but it leaves the user with free range on what they want to create.

**Impressions of Software:** This app reminded me of a very simple version of Inspiration. Since the app is so minimal and broad, I find it hard to believe that a

four-year-old or young child would have any use for it. This is an app that requires direction to get any use out of it. The students may lose interest in this app since there isn't much to it.
