The App we evaluated was Move The Turtle. Learn to code. We used Version 1.5.1 by Next is Great. The publisher states it is for ages 9 to 11, which we would agree with. It is a great tutorial app, because it teaches students a new skill. It is fun for older ages also and a younger student who is interested in coding would be able to use this app, however. This would fit into a technology curriculum or be an interesting special topic for a student who finished their work early. This app would really only be applicable in a single user environment. The only version of the app was \$3.99. There was not a lite version or a trial version.
