<p><b>Description of the Software</b></p>	<p>This app has a very modern feel to it and is brightly colored with the feature video on the main page that shows what the topic is and a picture to go with it. It has four buttons at the top to play the featured movie, start the quiz that goes with it, list the scores from any of the quizzes taken through the app, and shows related movies that can be watched to go along with the feature movie to help understand it better. At the bottom of the main page it lists each topic, a search, and a more section that gives more information on the app with a video that discusses BrainPOP. When you click on each subject matter it takes you to a page that is broken down by units or you can change it to be viewed by all topics. To view these videos you have to have a subscription.</p>
