<b>Description of the Software</b>	Upon opening this app it gives you the option to create an account or continue as a guest and after selecting your option there will be a screen that has four options - make, join, gallery, and search. Also, on this screen it will keep up with all the projects you have created. To create a new project you would need to click on make which then takes you to another screen with even more options to choose from to begin your project. You can select wall, canvas, stream, grid, shelf, backchannel, map, or timeline and they have an explanation of each one listed under them. It's pretty self explanatory once you are in each selection which helps you to create your project!
<b>Impression of the Software</b>	It seems very modern and up to date, it has a ton of different options to create the projects which is very impressive. It offers different ways to organize your information and then it even has the map and timeline. We think it would come in very handy in the classroom for both the teacher and the students.
