Types of Software with your Justification	This app could be used for drill and practice since you are utilizing it to learn vocabulary. It also utilizes discovery learning since you have free reign in how you want to set up the information on each word and can also be used as a tool since you are using the app to basically create flashcards.
Curriculum	This app targets vocabulary specifically so it could be used for vocabulary words to help students achieve a better understanding of the word.

Description of the Software	This app is to be used for help with vocabulary and has three options when you open it - review cards, learn, and about the app. You can add your vocabulary words and definitions under learn by adding a word. When you add the word it automatically pulls up a google search of the word providing its definition from several different websites. After writing in the definition of the word it gives you the option to write a story which is displayed like a text message conversation but where you can add in dialogue from each party to help explain the word. You also have the option to deconstruct the word into "meaningful parts" by breaking it down and then providing the definition for each part. The last option it provides when creating the vocab card is to make connections by entering phrases that will help with the definition. This information is all attached to the word when you review the definition.
Impression of the Software	I'm usually wary of apps that do not have any reviews because I want to make sure that it is established and the best version. This app is not one that I would use because I personally would want something simpler - with this app you have to manually enter in the vocab word and its definition. Yes, it is easier This app is not one that we would use because it seems like there is too much to do as far as creating the "cards". It would take too long to get all the information entered in verses just using regular flash cards or even another app.
