Type(s) of Software:

This app could be tutorial (introduction to new material), drill and practice (review of material already learned), discovery learning (students choose what to learn) and/or problem solving (students are provided problems and are required to solve them). Given the amount of content, this app is mostly drill and practice.

Curriculum(s):

Although this app is called iXL Math, it contains all of the content areas and grade levels, even down to Pre-K. It even includes language lessons.

Cost:

Allowed to complete minimal practice before requiring a subscription.

You can log in as guest or sign in. The screen is very cluttered and very boring. The best part of this app is that you can match it to specific state standards.
