30 minutes	Introduction:	They will be asked to think of memories that happened in Arkansas and why it is important to learn about our state. Students will then learn about Arkansas' state symbols through a book followed by an iMovie presentation on the carpet. Then we will sing the full length of the three songs from the movie.
15 minutes	Instruction:	"I want you to go back to your seat and I will come around and hand you a worksheet over what we just watched. This can be completed with your groups at your table but don't start until everyone has their paper because I will go over it with you." *I will hand out the worksheet and go over the directions listed on the page before allowing them to complete it. There will be matching, short answer, multiple choice questions, as well as coloring pictures. At the end, students will be asked to write a summary with lots of descriptive words about 3 things from the video.
15 minutes	Closure:	As a class, we will go over the worksheet. I will emphasize the importance of learning about Arkansas and review the symbols. Papers will be turned in and we will move onto our next lesson of the day.
