## Consequences for choosing to break classroom rules:

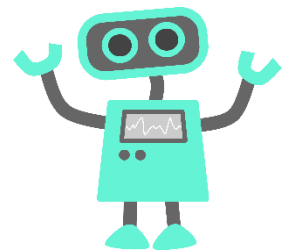
