



Acceptable Use Policy

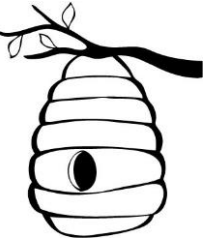


Classroom Rules:

1. BULLYING IS 100% UNACCEPTABLE AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES!
2. CHEATING IS 100% UNACCEPTABLE AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES!
3. Follow the morning routine, every morning!
 - a. Come in the classroom in Low Flow mode
 - b. Hang your things up in your cubby
 - c. Place your folders/papers in the INBOX
 - d. Get breakfast and take it to your seat
 - e. Clean up your area when you're done with breakfast
 - f. Start on morning work
4. Follow the noise level chart!
 - a. Loud Crowd – loud as a crowd
 - b. Low Flow – talk amongst your tablemates
 - c. Spy Mode – Whisper only
 - d. Ninja Mode – No noise at all
5. Use the hand system!
 - a. 5 fingers – to speak out loud
 - b. 4 fingers – to get a tissue
 - c. 3 fingers – to get a supply (pencil, paper, eraser, etc)
 - d. 2 fingers – to get a drink of water
 - e. 1 finger – to go to the restroom
 - f. Fist – the speak privately
6. Four On The Floor! Chairs MUST remain on all four legs all day long every day!

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Technology In The Classroom Rules:

1. Cyberbullying is 100% unacceptable!
2. Any cyberbullying will result in an immediate trip to principal's office!

4. Only visit teacher approved websites!
5. Any inappropriate online behavior will result in an immediate trip to principal's office!
6. Technology is only to be used at designated times unless approved by teacher!
7. Technology is only to be used in designated areas unless approved by teacher!
8. Technology does not leave the classroom for any reason!
9. No food or drinks are allowed near technology or technology areas!
10. If you are unsure or have questions about what you can or can't do, ASK THE TEACHER!

Additional Information:

1. Plagiarism is the use of someone else's work as your own, is wholly considered cheating and will be treated as such. Plagiarism may result in a failing grade and/or repeat performance of the work in addition to standard classroom consequences.
2. Copyright, per the Copyright Act, gives the original creators of books, films, movies, poems, games, etc. protection and control over the use of their work.
3. Fair Use is an evolving stipulation of the Copyright Act that allows use of Copyrighted materials for reasonable and understandable reasons.



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Classroom Consequences:

1. Failure to follow these rules will result in disciplinary actions as follows:
 - a. Verbal warning

 - c. Note home and phone call to grown up
 - d. Trip to principal's office
