

Mini-Lesson: Compare and Contrast

1.) Grade level/Audience: 2nd Grade

2.) Curriculum topic: Language Arts: similarities and differences of stories RL.2.9 Compare and contrast two or more versions of the same story (e.g., Cinderella stories) by different authors or from different cultures.

3.) Tools: Kahoot and Inspiration

4.) Synopsis of what I'm doing and how I am using the tools. How are the students doing it?

Individually, whole class, group of 3 etc.

In this lesson, I will be incorporating Inspiration and Kahoot to enhance the lesson.

As a class, we will be comparing/contrasting the book Cinderella from two different artists Marcia Brown, and Don Williams. We will read the stories as a class, and then create an Inspiration chart that compares and contrasts the two stories.

Once my students have a good understanding of the differences of the books, students will participate in a Kahoot game. The questions will consist of similarities and differences from both of the Cinderella stories. I think Kahoot would be fun to check for understanding while my students are having fun.
