As a teacher on wizer.me it gives you the ability to create your own work sheets. As a student on wizer.me you will be added to your teachers classroom and able to view the worksheets that your teacher has created for you. When creating your account as a teacher it asks you questions about what you teach and what grade to help offer the things that will be the most useful to you. The website offers options for matching, sorting, multiple choice, fill in the blank, and many other options. It also offers a lot of cute backgrounds and pictures for each subject.

I would use this website whenever I just can't find a worksheet that has all of the content in it that I am wanting to assess my students over. Remind

With remind, teachers and parents can be connected with each other effectively, in a safe environment, without having to give out or share any phone numbers. You can also send out reminders or updates about anything that may be necessary.

This seems much more effective then sending home a note about a sign up sheet, and the updates go straight to the parents phone.

Live Binders

Live binders lets you create "binders" online. You can put any documents you like in these "binders" you can share access with these binders to parents and students so they can access all of the important documents you might be sharing for them.

As a teacher I would create a "binder" for each subject and one for take home forms. This allows parents access to the homework and take home forms if students lose them, for example, if there is permission slip that needs to be turned in the next day, but the child lost theirs, the parent can get access to this permission slip so the student can turn it in on time.
