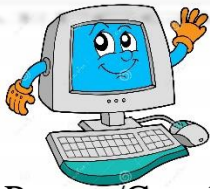

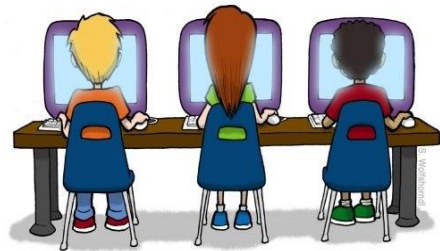
Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

Every day the students will start their name out on the **Ready to learn in green**. As the day progresses and they will either move up the chart or down. Moving up the chart to **Good Job**, **Awesome** and **Amazing** means they are doing an excellent job in class! If their name moves down the chart to **Slow Down**, **Think About It** or **Parent Contact** means that we need to work on making better choices. Every day I will mark your child's behavior for the day and put it in their Take Home Notebooks so you will access if you want it. If your child gets on red for Parent Contact, I or the office will contact you about the situation.

ALSO-Any serious offenses such as cyberbullying, inappropriate use of technology or destruction of property will be immediately sent to the office and a parent will be contacted.
