Animal Groups Lesson Plan- YouTube and Kahoot

Grade Level/ Audience: This lesson is for third graders.

Curriculum topic: This is a science lesson aligned with "3-LS2-1

Construct an argument that some animals form groups that help

members survive."

Tools: Youtube and Kahoot

Synopsis: The class will start at the carpet and I will show the YouTube video, Animal Groups (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fP54QWi-aiM), about the different animal groups. The video is meant to get the students thinking about why some animals live in groups.

Questions such as Is it for protection? for companionship? Do they stay together only as young? And several others. Then I will discuss these questions with the students and see what they think the answers are. After that I will go over a power point that discusses the questions. Next, I will have the students to break into groups of three. Each group will need an iPad. I will post questions on Kahoot and each group will answer the questions. Whichever group answers correctly first, then they will receive a point. The winning team will get candy.
