

Classroom Rules:

- 1. Follow directions.
- 2. Keep hands, feet, and body to yourself.
- 3. Demonstrate good listening skills.
- 4. Use inside voices.
- 5. Complete assignments.
- 6. Show respect for all adults, students, and school property.

Rules for Technology Use:

The following rules pertain to any form of technology including, but not limited to any computers, iPads, smart boards, Internet, projectors, and any other form of technology used in the classroom.

- 1. Students will only use the Internet in ways the teacher has approved.
- 2. Students will use computers for schoolwork only, not for any other reason.
- 3. Students will not use technology to threaten or bully any other person. This includes other students, teachers, etc.
- 4. Students will not damage any form of technology.
- 5. Students will handle all forms of technology with care.
- 6. Students will not carry or move technology without the teacher's permission.
- 7. If students are carrying a laptop, they will use two hands to carry it to the appropriate location.
- 8. Each student will have an appropriate time limit that he/she will have to engage in the use of technology during each school day. The teacher reserves the right to change time limits as she sees fit.

Internet Usage:

- 1. Students will only access sites that are teacher approved.
- 2. Students will not use the Internet to engage in cyberbullying, or any other inappropriate behavior.

- 3. Students will may use the Internet to complete assignments or any other work assigned to them. Ex: google classroom
- 4. Students will use the Internet to conduct research.
- 5. Students will not download anything unless the teacher has approved it.

Consequences for misusing technology:

- 1. Verbal warning for first offense.
- 2. Missed recess
- 3. Loss of technology privileges
- 4. Due to the severity of the offense, students may be referred to the principal or assistant principal.
- 5. If the student continues to misuse his /her technology privileges, a parent/teacher conference will be scheduled to discuss the student's behavior.

Plagiarism, Fair Use, and Copyright Use:

Students will not plagiarize; take credit for someone else's work, while using the Internet or any other form of technology. Students will limit the amount of information they obtain from various resources, and will not use information or images that contain a copyright. For more information, please visit my website.
