# Rules when using the Internet:

- 1. I will not plagiarize or copy anyone's work without citing the source.
- 2. I will not bully anyone while on the internet.
- 3. I will not be on any cite the teacher does not approve of.
- 4. If there is a problem, I will come to my teacher for help.
- 5. There will be a time limit of 35 minutes for the student to use the computer. (Could change depending on teacher.)

## Consequences:

Breaking the internet rules can lead to the loss of internet privileges.

Breaking the technology rules can lead to the loss of technology privledges.

Breaking these classroom rules can also lead to consequences depending on what I decide. Consequences in my classroom include going to the principal's office, getting recess time taken away, or getting strikes.

<u>Strikes</u> include getting a warning (1<sup>st</sup> offense), loosing privileges (2<sup>nd</sup> offense), and going to the principal's office or teacher contacting parents (3<sup>rd</sup> offense).

## Copyright:

This is the right given to creators of original work to make sure that no one can take it and say it is theirs. This prevents internet users from taking certain work and using it as their own. So, make sure you give credit! ©

### Fair Use:

Fair Use is a doctrine that allows a leeway for students and schools to use certain material for educational purposes.

#### Plagiarism:

This is when someone takes someone else's work and uses it as their own. Miss Molly does not allow plagiarism in her classroom and wants you to show her your own ideas and work! If she sees any signs of plagiarism, there will be strikes given. (Depending on what she decides.)
