


















Internet Rules!

I will use a three level Consequence chart. Each student

will have a card to start out the day. This card will be GREEN,

- Orange- This means they have had some behavioral problems and they have lost some type of privilege and we had to have a talk during their resses time, and a note sent home
- Red- This means they have disobeyed many rules or the same one multiple times in one day. This will result in a trip to the principle, a note sent home, and/or a parent teacher meeting set up if received this card multiple days in a row.
 - > Punishment does not have to follow this order, action of student will fit punishment.
