

Lesson Plan Idea Format

This is an introductory lesson for a week long series about communities after natural disasters

History App

Textbook

Notecards

Procedure:

First they will use the this day in history app to find some type of disaster that happened on that day in history (I will make sure we start this lesson on a day that this can for sure be found)

Next we will go over together different disasters in history

Finally to end the intro lesson the students will write on notecards 3 important facts about the disasters we talked about and will write one question they have about the recovery process which we will talk about in a later lesson.

Assessment (How will the students' show you that the objective has been met):

The assessment for the first intro lesson is coming through the notecards they are writing on. This provides me what they got out of the lesson and what they want to know more about.

A Brief Description Of The Entire Lesson - Plus Any Additional Information to be Included:

Disasters we will go over together will be hurricanes like Katrina, tornadoes like Joplin, and man-made disasters like Chernobyl.

After the intro lesson we will go over how these disasters affected the people in those areas and how they built back as a community.
