

## Lesson Plan Idea Format

**Grade Level & Subject Area:** 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies

Materials will include videos, handouts, and one flag that will be used to show demonstrations.

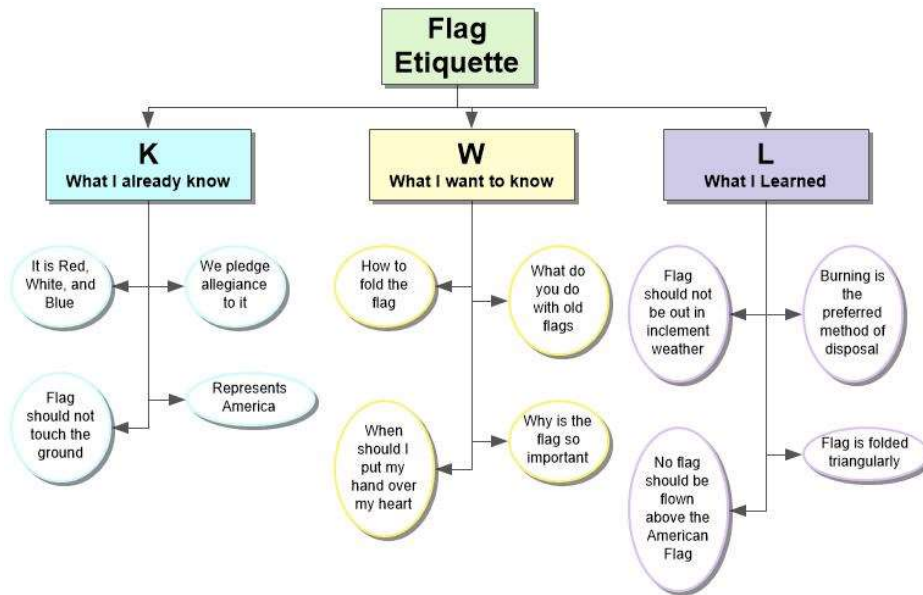
**Procedure:**

First, students will fill out a handout provided by me that is or is similar to a KWL. They will fill portions of this out before and after the lesson. We will watch videos that properly show the etiquette of the flags and then go over the proper procedures when it comes to the flags. After the videos and interactive lecture, I will give a demonstration of how to properly fold the flags. Most likely will also have a guest speaker that will be involved in this demonstration. This will be followed with an assessment.

**Assessment (How will the students' show you that the objective has been met):**

They will be given an easy fill in the blank assessment that involves the steps of folding an American flag. They will also turn in their KWL type handout to let me see what they think they knew and learned throughout the lesson.



**A Brief Description Of The Entire Lesson - Plus Any Additional Information to be Included:**

This is a quick lesson about etiquette in terms of the American flag. Students will learn about displaying, folding, and retiring the American flag through a guest speaker, videos, and a demonstration of flag folding.
