There are in-app purchases unless the user wants to purchase the full use of the app for the \$0.99 as stated above.

**Description of Software:** This software allows the user to create a map of ideas, items, or educational material. The app can be used for grocery lists, study guides, or even a brainstorm map to help write an essay. The user starts by creating a main idea and then builds from that main idea and connects the areas with arrows. You can change the color of each bubble you create as well as the font and shape.

**Impression of Software:** My impression of the software is not the best because I do not feel like students would have a lot of interest in this app. I do not feel like this app could be used in the classroom for any reason because the map can become confusing and not get the main idea across. The bad aspects of the app are the screen design because it is just plain white with no bells and whistles to be added.
