Classroom Rules

Technology Rules

1. Do Not Eat or Drink Near Devices

4. Be Sensitive when using Equipment
5. Leave Workstations Better than how it was found
6. Print and download items only if you have permission.
7. If you don't have to use devices, don't be on them so others who need them can use them.

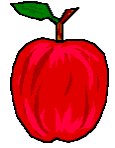
Internet Rules

1. Only Visit Approved Sites and Applications
2. Do not interact with strangers
3. Never give out your personal information
4. Zero tolerance of cyberbullying, if you see it, report it.
5. Don't click on anything suspicious
6. Exhibit appropriate online behavior at all times.



Additional Information

- **Plagiarism** is the act of taking someone else's work and using it as your own and it will NOT be tolerated
- **Cheating** is the act of taking someone else's work and using it as your own and it will NOT be tolerated
- **Copyright** is a type of intellectual property that protects the original creator.
 - Just because you found it online, that doesn't make it free to use.
 - They're plenty of free alternates typically.
 - Just be responsible while searching the web for information and pictures.
- **Fair Use** is a provision of the Copyright Act that allows certain uses of copyrighted works without permission. However, this does not mean you can freely use all copyrighted materials.
