Title: Kahoot! Play & Create Quizzes

Target Audience: Kids 4+

Type(s) of Software: Tools - students can create their own quizzes using Kahoot, and develop a greater understanding of the curriculum through their own creation.

Curriculum(s): This can easily fit the school's curriculum, depending on how it is used. As I stated in the checklist, I am reviewing Kahoot as a tool for students to create quizzes with. This could easily fit into our curriculum if the students were to use it to create quizzes based on what they are studying in class. In my class, the students used Kahoot to create personalized quizzes about themselves to get to know each other. However, say for example that we were studying Multi-Step Equations (7.EE.A.1-2). I could have my students create quizzes based on the standards we study in class.

Cost: There is a free option, which has plenty of versatility for student use. There are options for subscription levels that give more options and accessibility. Options: These are all billed *annually*

- Pro Subscription: \$3.00/month
- Premium Subscription: \$6.00/month
- Premium+ Subscription: Typically \$9/month, but currently on sale for \$6.00/month.

Explaining the Software: The primary use of *Kahoot* is for teachers to create/use premade quizzes to give to their students in class. It creates an environment for friendly competition between students, and allows for them to compete with each other. I like this, because it encourages the students to do better on their quizzes.

Students can also create their own free account on *Kahoot* and create their own quizzes. I like this option because students can be given the opportunity to create

quizzes over what is being studied in class, which can allow for an even deeper level of understanding over the topic.

Impressions / Can I Use it in My Class? Although *Kahoot* is widely overused, I like the software a lot. It is very easily accessible on the iPad, and is recognized by the students. I can definitely use it in my classroom
