

Title: Adobe Premier Rush for Video

Target audience: Video editors

Type of software with justification: Tools. Users make videos by combining and editing raw footage.

Curriculum: This can be used in projects for any class, if a video project is the better outcome.

Cost: Free to make videos, have up to 2 GB of Cloud storage, and export 3 videos. \$9.99/month for unlimited shares and 100 GB of Cloud storage.

Description of software:

The first screen is a place where your projects are at. You can create new projects with a plus button at the bottom. The main editing screen has a timeline at the bottom that contains the clips you are working on. The right side has all of the effects on it. The left side has the tools to edit the timeline with. The top/middle is a preview window for your video.

Impression of software (how it will be used in a classroom):

This software can be used for final projects in nearly any class. It's simple enough to quickly learn how to use it, but also powerful enough to do what you want to with it. I would personally prefer the accuracy of a mouse while using a video editor, but this is plenty sufficient for simple applications.
