

INTERNET SAFETY RULES

Our parents teach us the rules to be safe in our nondigital lives from an early age. It is important to know how to be safe in our digital lives as well!

- 1. There will be NO TOLERANCE for any form of cyberbullying. If you see something, say something.
- 2. Do not download anything unless instructed to do so.

- 3. Do not share any personal information online! Never give anyone your address, phone number, full name, etc.
- 4. If you see anything that makes you uncomfortable, please let me or another trusted adult know immediately!
- 5. Do not click on any unfamiliar links or stray to any websites that are not approved.

PLAGIARISM: This is when you take someone else's work (writing, art, etc.) and use it as if it's your own work. This is the same as cheating or stealing and it is extremely important to avoid plagiarizing another person's work.

PLAGIARISM, COPYRIGHT, AND FAIR USE

COPYRIGHT: This is the legal right awarded to anyone for their creative works. For any tangible form of creative expression, we can assume that it is protected by copyright laws. It's important to keep in mind copyright laws when looking for resources to use for projects and other work. FAIR USE: This is the idea that someone should be able to use small pieces of another person's work for commentary, criticizing, or parody purposes without infringing on copyright laws.

CONSEQUENCES

The rules included in this policy are meant to ensure student safety. Therefore, when rules are broken, there must be consequences.

If a student fails to treat our technology with care or use the approved sites, he or she will:

- 1. Receive a warning and be expected to improve the behavior.
- 2. If the behavior continues, the student will not be able to participate in the use of technology until further notice.

STOP

If a student is caught cyberbullying, he or she will: 1. Automatically receive a write up and a call home.

2. If the behavior continues, the student will be sent to the office and a more serious consequence will be determined.

If a student is caught plagiarizing, he or she will: 1. Review the rules on the importance of turning in original work and redo the assignment without plagiarizing.
