

Catch the Key Details

Grade Level: First

Curriculum Topic: Reading – ask and answer questions about key details in a text

Tools: Kahoot! and book - *Webster's Manners*

Synopsis: Students will learn about key details in a text and how to spot them. We will read the book *Webster's Manners* as a class. As I read aloud, the students are to pay attention to main points, or 'key details.' Once we have finished the story, the students will grab their iPads and log on to Kahoot. I will create a Kahoot quiz that asks questions pertaining to the book, *Webster's Manners*, and its key details, like the characters and the different manners that are mentioned. I will display the quiz code on the screen so the students can join the game. Once everyone has joined, we will begin to play the review Kahoot game. Students are to answer the questions individually on their iPads, but once answered, we will discuss each question as a class. This activity provides the students with the opportunity to participate in a drill and practice game, as well as show them that technology can be a fun tool for learning. The book *Webster's Manners* will teach the students about digital manners and behaviorisms.
