## Consequences

## Ms. McClung's 3rd Grade Class

Listed below are consequences that students will receive if they choose to break the rules listed on the previous page

- 1. For bullying anyone:
  - a. First Offense: Students will be required to issue a written apology to the person that they have bullied and will have a conference with the teacher about bullying
  - b. Second Offense: Students will be required to issue a written apology to the person that they have bullied and will have a conference with the principal about bullying
  - c. Third Offense: Students will be required to issue a written apology to the person that they have bullied, will receive a referral, and will be sent to the principal's office to discuss further consequences
- 2. For disrespecting classmates and teachers:
  - a. First Offense: Students will receive a warning
  - b. Second Offense: Students will issue a written apology
  - c. Third Offense: Students will issue a written apology and will have a conference with the teacher regarding their behavior
  - d. Fourth Offense: Students will be required to issue a written apology and will have a conference with the principal to discuss further consequences
- 3. For using computers for inappropriate, illegal and unapproved behavior:
  - a. First Offense: Students will be asked to exit the websites that have not been approved or that have illegal or inappropriate content and will receive a warning
  - Second Offense: Students will be asked to exit the websites that have not been approved or that have illegal or inappropriate content and will have their computer privileges revoked for the rest of the day

- c. Third Offense: Students will be asked to exit the websites that have not been approved or that have illegal or inappropriate content, will have the computer privileges revoked for the rest of the day and will be sent to the principal's office to discuss further consequences
- 4. For plagiarism:
  - a. Students will receive a zero on the assignment and will be sent to the principal's office to discuss further consequences
- 5. For damaging the computer:
  - a. Students will be required to pay for damages to their computer
