- 2. Curriculum: Bill of Rights
- 3. Tools: **Naiku** is a tool that teachers can use to create quizzes that students can answer using a device and it is a great way for you to check their understanding either through or after the lesson. **Lino** is another online tool you can use to be interactive with your students. This online tool is a virtual corkboard of stick notes so students can provide questions or comments on their learning. These can be uses as exit tickets, or even bell ringers to start the class or topic of discussion.
