Grade Level: Kindergarten

Curriculum: Social Studies

Tools: iPad, Camera, Gmail, iMovie and Smartboard

This is going to be a picture scavenger hunt! This lesson would be great to be centered around a specific activity rather than just a general hunt. For my example students are going to look around the school to find the leprechaun on St. Patrick's Day. This lesson would be done best collaborating with the other classes but can be done individually as well. Create a video using iMovie pretending to be a leprechaun hiding somewhere in the school. Project this on the Smart Board for all the students to see. He should say he left clues around the school and it is the student's job to use those clues to find him- the first team there wins. Students will then be separated into a group of 5 and given one iPad per group. They must then pick a job for each student- picture taker, emailer, clue decoder, iPad protector, and lifeline. When they find the first clue, they take a picture, email it to me, and I respond with the next clue. This activity will get children familiar with email and make it less scary to reach out to their teacher if need be. The clues should include an educational fact about the activity for example one could say "leprechaun means small body." What ever team is able to decode the clues and find the leprechaun first will win!
