Mini Lesson 6

This will be a mini lesson for my 7th grade ELA class.

Students will read a story, study the story and the elements that go into it, and create their own parody of the story. This will contain a similar situation, but with different characters, elements, or settings. Students will then record themselves reading this book on VPOD or Clips, and share with the class to watch.

I will read the story, "Goodnight iPad: a Parody for the next generation" by Ann Droyd. We will discuss the different features that she added. This can be figurative language, to a plot twist. Students will then have an outline of a book they get to create. This outline will be where they develop their plot and resolution. This book will have empty pages for words and pictures to be added. They will be required to have creative characters and settings. The students will then video themselves reading the short story and upload it for the class to watch. They can video using VPOD, Clips, or any other app or tool they may be aware of.
