

## Videos in my Class

### Lesson 1

When doing a presentation over rainfall, students will use videos to give their presentation. The video will show the rainfall that they've collected and the results that they came up with. This will allow different groups to compare their results. This can be done in Clips or a similar app so students can stop and start to gather materials and show charts that they create.

### Lesson 2

When doing a unit over short stories, students will video themselves reading their short stories. This will be a way of presentation and assessment. I will see how their short stories turned out, and their classmates will get to hear the short stories that they created. This will be done on VPOD as a way to quickly record and post.

### Lesson 3

When doing a math problem assigned to them, they can work it out and explain how they reached their answer through video. This can be solving fractions or ratios. This is a way of assessment. I can see how the student is thinking, what I need to retouch in my lesson, and if they understand the process.

### Lesson 4

When studying a time period and situation in history, students can recreate an important scene in history. They can develop a script with their group, and bring props. They can then video their skit and scene. Each group will have a different scene that goes together. When they all video their part, we will combine them into one video that connects each small scene.
