Math Drill is a good drill and practice app for students who are still struggling with multiplication and division. It allows the students to practice the problems and get better at solving them. Although multiplication and division is taught in younger grades, I feel like it is necessary for 6th graders to have access to it because math builds on these basics. The students who get better at the basics will have an easier time understanding and following along with the actual lesson at hand. Math drill can be used on both Android and iOS systems.

Math Drill is a free app created by the company Galapagos Breeze. This app likes to crash on an Android device every time you solve a problem because it lacks an update. However, it would be a useful tool to get students to master the basics of math. The music was upbeat but could be distracting for students so I would suggest turning it off. There is also a chime or buzzer if the student gets the answer wrong or right. You can choose what kind of problems you do. For example, you can do long division and multiplication or shorter versions of the two. Math Drill went straight to the point and there were no complications on what to do. I

believe this app could work well in the classroom but since it likes to crash, I would suggest finding a different one to use for drill and practice.
