PhotoMath Evaluation

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The app, PhotoMath, is a good tool for students to use at home if they are struggling on math homework. All they have to do is take a picture of the problem and it will tell them how to solve it. If you have purchased the app, you can also see definitions of the math terms it uses if it is highlighted orange. Students can also find their book on the app and it will be able to show them how to solve the problems in it. Each step can be seen into further detail if the student doesn't understand how they got to that point. This way, they can find an easy solution without stressing about unfinished homework. Photomath works on mobile devices with iOS 10.0 or higher and Android OS version 5.0 and higher.

Damir Sabol is the creator of PhotoMath. The app's main screen is just a camera. However, it changes to a solution page once you have taken a picture of a math problem. The app is easy to learn and straight to the point on what to do. There is a snapping sound when taking a photo but other than that there is no sound when using the app so it isn't distracting for the user. The app is free but the user has to pay additional cost to look at the vocabulary words and see problems out of their book. The costs are the following: 1 month is \$9.99, 6 months is \$49.99, and 1 year is \$59.99.
