Where's my water 2 is a free problem-solving app that allows the user to figure out how to get the water to their goal. You can help students to think critically to find the solution to the problem. Since students are thinking about how to solve it, the style allows it to be kid friendly for all ages. I would use this game to get my students to think without them knowing during free time. This way they are still keeping their brain active. This app is available for both iOS and Android.

Where's my water 2 was developed by creature feep and twitch. This app had a colorful scree and joyful music to get the user interested in playing. The extra sounds were appropriate for the theme of the game. It was easy to learn and navigate your way through while playing. If you run out of water to complete your task, it will give you bummed out music that signals a game over. This app would be a fun way for the user to figure out the solution. In addition, they can try to collect all the ducks before completely the goal. This could add more critical thinking for the user to use. I felt like Where's my water 2 had a similar style to cut the rope as a puzzle game. Where's my water 2 is a free game but the first one

cost \$1.99. In addition, there are in game purchases for either a starter bundle that cost \$2.99 or a monster bundle that cost \$9.99.
