Basic Classroom Rules

1. Follow Directions.
2. Be respectful to both my teacher and my peers.
3. Don't touch other's things without asking for permission first.

Computer/Technology Rules

5. Screen time will be limited to 25-35 minutes.



Internet Rules

1. Only use the computers for your schoolwork, unless given permission from the teacher.
2. Only use the websites given to you by the teacher or approved by the teacher.
3. Tell the teacher when someone is doing something inappropriate on the computers.
4. Do not give your password to anyone else.
5. Again, no bullying of any kind will be tolerated; including cyberbullying.

Consequences for Breaking the Rules

We will have a card system in the classroom; green, yellow, red, blue, and purple (all children start on green).

- **Green:** starting point, doing well and following directions.
- **Yellow:** The student will be given a verbal warning.
- **Red:** The student will lose recess/technology time.
- **Blue:** A note/letter will be sent home to parents, which may result in a conference.
- **Purple:** The student will be sent to the office.

**If you abuse the use of technology or any objects in the classroom, you will lose your privileges.

Plagiarism

Plagiarism is the practice of taking someone else's work or ideas and passing them off as your own.

Plagiarism will not be tolerated and there will be consequences for doing this.

Plagiarism can be:

- Using someone else's work
- Turning in an old assignment of yours
- Not citing your sources

Copyright and Fair Use Policy

Copyright is for the protection of people's work. We are not allowed to use their work if it is copyrighted, unless we have that author's permission. The fair use policy means that if someone's work is copyrighted, you may use part of their work as long as the source is cited; if there is no citation, then your work will be considered plagiarism.
