to ask a question.



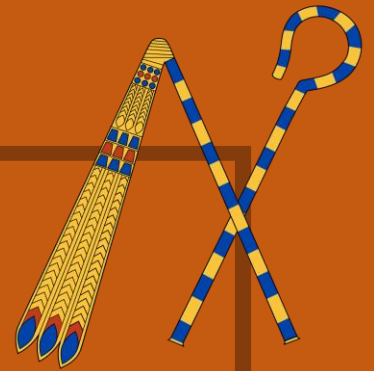
# WHEN CAN I USE A QUESTION MARK?

hieroglyphics?

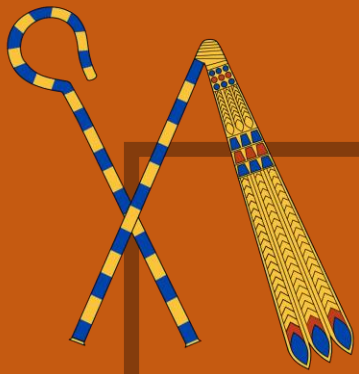


In this sentence, we are

Use an exclamation mark when you are wanting to express how you feel.

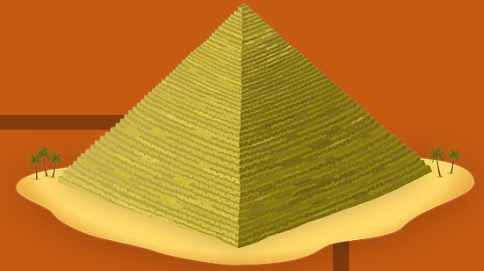


# WHEN CAN I USE AN EXCLAMATION MARK?

There are camels!



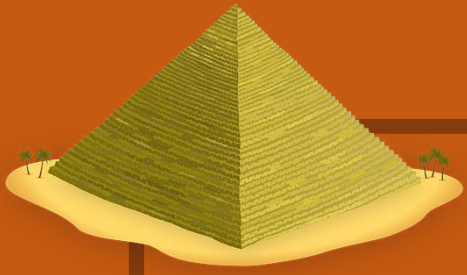
In this sentence, we are excited about the camels. Therefore, we use an exclamation mark.

Use a period when you are ending a thought.

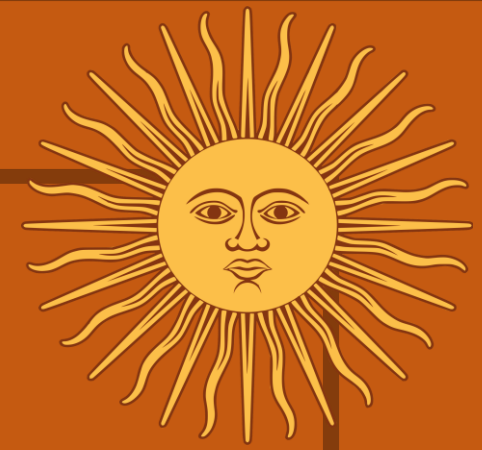


# WHEN CAN I USE A PERIOD?

separate a list of words.



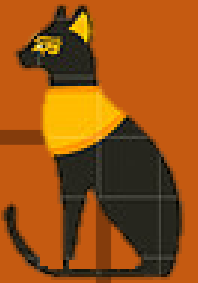


# WHEN CAN I USE A COMMA?

them.



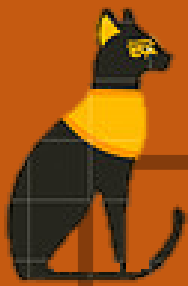
