Mini Lesson #4

Grade Level: 1st

Topic: Working with Time

Standard:

AR.Math.Content.K.MD.C.4- Understand concepts of time including morning, afternoon, evening, today, yesterday, tomorrow, day, week, month, and year. *AR.Math.Content.1.MD.B.3*- Tell and write time in hours and half-hours using analog and digital clocks.

Tools: Smart Exchange & Word & Google Classroom

Synopsis: For this activity, students will be sitting in their groups, but will be paying attention to the front of the classroom at the board. First, we will go over the Telling Time SmartBoard activity. I will call students up to the board one by one to complete each problem on the activity. After we learn how to tell time and write time in hours and half hours using analog clocks, in groups of two, students will create their own clock using tools in Word. Students will be given instructions on how to begin creating their own analog clock. They should begin becoming familiar with shapes and functions on Word also. After completing their clocks with their partner, one student from the group will upload the clock that their group made onto Google Classroom.
