After the video, I will ask the students to discuss with their table one thing that learned from the video. We will take a few minutes to discuss this as a class. Centers: American Symbol Cards center: students will identify the symbol that each card displays. I will be guiding this center. I will ask a series of questions to assess their understanding and knowledge of national symbols. Summative assessment Technology Center: Students will be directed to a national symbols kid friendly website where they can explore and extend their knowledge of national symbols and patriotic songs Worksheet symbols: students will be given a worksheet that will ask them to identify and match symbols. This will be the formal assessment
