

Mini-lesson: Coins!

1.) Grade level/Audience: Kindergarten

2.) Curriculum topic: AR.Math.Content.K.MD.C.6 Identify pennies, nickels, and dimes, and know the value of each. This is an introduction skill and is addressed more formally in the upcoming grade levels.

3.) Tools: YouTube video from ABCmouse.com

4.) Synopsis of what I'm doing and how I am using the tools. How are the students doing it? Individually, whole class, group of 3 etc.: At the start of the class I will introduce the YouTube video that I linked above. This will give the students the opportunity to better understand where we will be going over and the cute little song that the YouTube video plays may help with memorizing the value of each coin. After the video I will then pull up a premade PowerPoint to play jeopardy. I will split the students up into two teams of equal or almost equal ability. We will then play jeopardy through the PowerPoint keeping track of the points throughout the game and the winning team will get to choose from the treasure box.
