

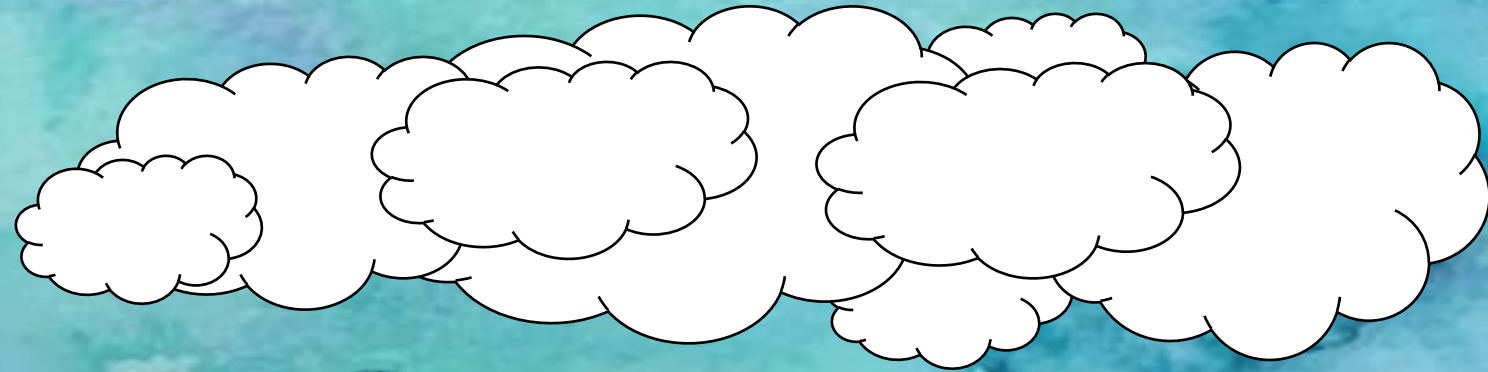


Punctuation

When you see me at the end of the sentence that means a question is being asked. Take time to think about the answer

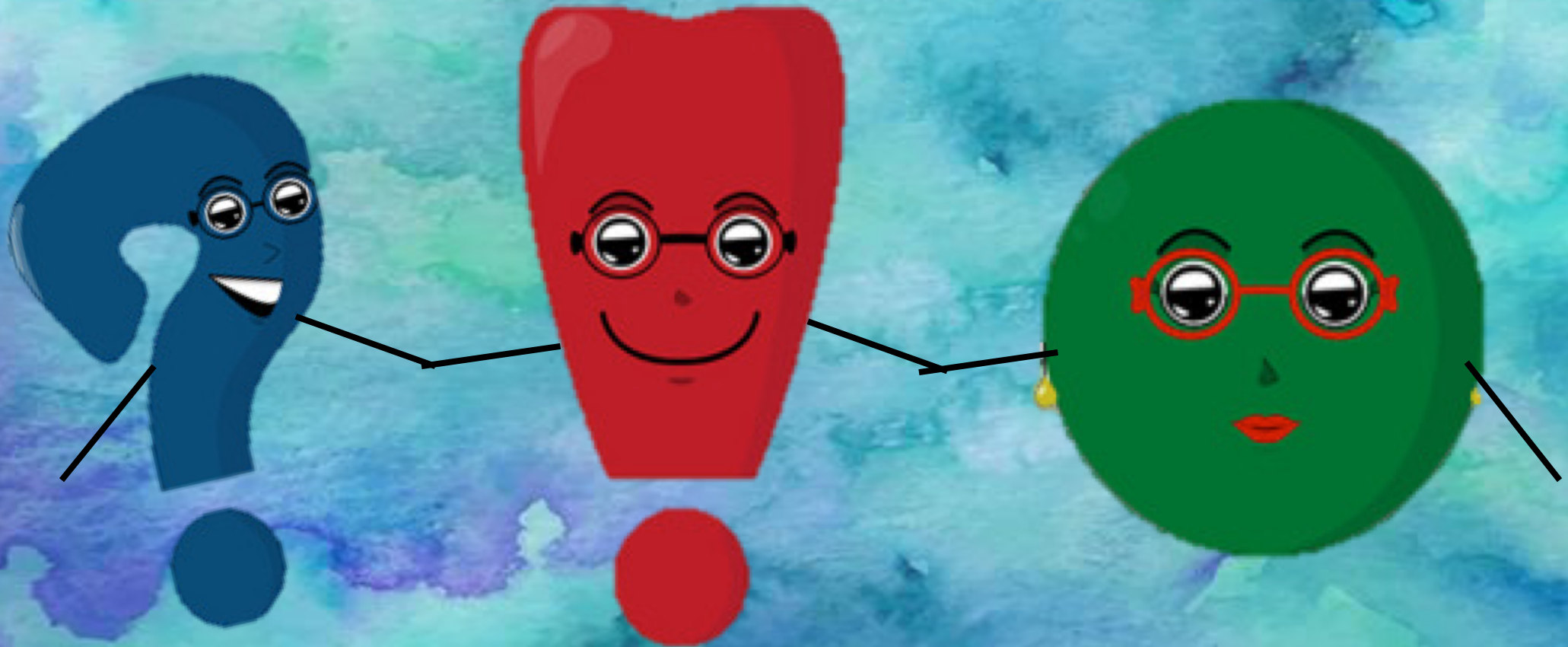
I am an exclamation point. I have a job too!
